* (b) The governing board, president, superintendent, principal, or school resource officer of any public institution of elementary, secondary, or higher education, or a person designated in writing by the board or any of these persons, may deny access to the buildings or grounds of the institution to any other person who (1) is not a bona fide, currently registered student or staff or faculty member at the institution, and who does not have lawful business to pursue at the institution; or (2) is a bona fide, currently registered student at the institution and has been suspended or expelled from the institution, for the duration of the suspension or expulsion; or (3) Acts in a manner that disrupts or disturbs the normal educational functions of the institution ... (c) A person is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000, imprisonment not exceeding 6 months, or both if he (1) Trespasses on the grounds of any public institution of elementary, secondary, or higher education [or] (2) Falls or refuses to leave the grounds of any of these institutions after being requested to do so by a person designated in subsection (b) of this section as being authorized to deny access to the buildings or grounds of the institution ...
